# DGSA LEAGUE DIVISIONS

## AGES 5 -15

**U6 LEAGUE: (girls 5 & 6 years old) Age 5 by January 1, 2008 and not over 6 on January 1, 2008.** This league will play Tuesday & Thursday nights normally 2 days per week at 5:15. Short practices followed by non-scored games. The goal of this league is to introduce the athletes to the concepts of softball. The season will last 4 weeks and begin in early-June and end in early-July. Coach pitch only.

**U8 LEAGUE: (Girls ages 7 & 8 years old) Age 8 or under on January 1, 2008.** The girls will play on Tuesday & Thursday night normally 2 days a week at 5:00 pm and 6:30 pm. (There will be one Saturday Game in June.) Games will begin in May and end by approximately July 1<sup>st</sup>. The goal of this league is to introduce the concepts of softball to the athletes and to have the athletes compete in non-scored games. Coach pitch.

**U10 LEAGUE: (Girls ages 9 & 10 years old) Age 10 or under on January 1, 2008.** The girls will play on Monday and Wednesday nights normally 2 days per week at 5:00pm, 6:30pm, or 8:00pm. (There will be one Saturday Game in June.) Games will begin in May and end around July 15<sup>th</sup>. The goal of this league is to teach softball fundamentals, play in scored games and introduce basic softball strategy. Player pitch. Scored Games.

**U12 LEAGUE: (Girls ages 11 & 12 years old) Age 12 or under on January 1, 2008.** The girls will play on Tuesday & Thursday nights normally 2 days a week at 5:00 pm, 6:30 pm, or 8:00pm. (There will be one Saturday Game in June.) Games will begin in May and end around July 15<sup>th</sup>. The goal of this league is to re-enforce softball fundamentals and teach basic softball strategy following ASA age appropriate guidelines. Player pitch. Scored Games.

**SENIOR LEAGUE: (Girls ages 13 through 15 years old) Age 15 or under on January 1, 2008.** The girls will play on Monday and Wednesday at 4:30 pm, 6:30pm, or 8:00pm normally 2 days per week. (There will be one Saturday Game in June.) Games will begin in June and end around August 1<sup>st</sup>. The goal of this league is to teach softball fundamentals and softball strategy following age appropriate ASA guidelines. Athletes who are entering this league for the first year will need to participate in a try-out session in March or April.

### **DEPERE GIRLS TUESDAY NIGHT LEAGUE (Registration Fee \$30.00)**

DGSA sponsors a Tuesday Night League to give high school players in Northeast Wisconsin an opportunity to play very competitive softball during the summer months after the school season ends. DGSA sponsors two teams made up of players from the DGSA Senior League. The girls are eligible if they are in their second or third year of Senior League play. Tryouts will be held before season begins. The season runs from June to early August. Games will be played on Tuesday night at VFW and Legion Parks in DePere. The DGSA Tuesday night teams may also play several weekend tournament games throughout the season if opportunities become available.

# DGSA Tournament Team Guidelines

## Purpose:

- A.) To provide DGSA girls in the U10, U12 and U14 age divisions an opportunity to play softball against teams outside of the normal DGSA league.
- B.) Sportsmanship, skill development and having fun will be the primary objectives, but winning and competition does have a higher priority on tournament teams than it does in normal league play
- C.) To provide the DePere and West DePere school districts with fundamentally sound players ready for high school play.

## Guidelines:

- A.) Player and coach numbers will determine whether there could be one or more teams in each age class.
- B.) Preseason tryouts will be required to insure that all girls have the skills needed to play safe tournament ball and to determine team placement. If skill development is not at a level for tournament team play the player will not be assigned a team. The goal however will be to allow all girls that are qualified the opportunity to play. Tryouts will take place in February and March. You must tryout to play.
- C.) Players are not guaranteed equal playing time, but some opportunity to play in each tournament will be guaranteed even though it maybe limited.
- D.) On the field player positions will be determined by the coach and maybe limited to one or more positions.
- E.) A commitment to be at practices is a requirement of playing on a tournament team. Playing time can be effected by missing practices.
- F.) Players must play in their respected age division. No moving up to another age class will be allowed.

## Eligibility:

- A.) To be a Player on a DGSA Tournament Team you must be a current player on a DGSA league team.
- B.) The Player must attend a public or private school in the East or West DePere School Districts or have principle residence in the East or West DePere School District. (Note: If you were a 2007 tournament player you do not need to meet this requirement to be a player on a 2008 team.)

## Team Formation:

- A.) Tournament Select;
    - 1.) Players will be split into West and East DePere teams.
    - 2.) Plays four to six weekend tournaments starting in late spring.
    - 3.) The team will be limited to twelve players.
    - 4.) Cuts will take place if more than twelve girls register.
  - B.) Tournament Elite;
    - 1.) If additional players try out and qualify than can fit on the two Select teams an additional team or teams may be formed. It maybe a combined West and East DePere team. Team make up and formation of these teams will be at the discretion of the coaches and tournament coordinator.
    - 2.) Plays four to six weekend tournaments starting in late spring
    - 3.) These teams may vary in size but will only have active twelve players per tournament.
- “Select” and “Elite” teams may share position players if needed due to vacations or lack of players skilled at a certain position. Players not registered on or that did not tryout for a DGSA tournament team will not be allowed to substitute.

\_\_\_\_\_ **FIELD MAINTANANCE** – Help prep fields for games or works on facility improvement projects.

\_\_\_\_\_ **PRACTICE TIME FIELD COORDINATOR** – Manages master schedule and field times for team preseason practices. Handles practice time draft at coaches meeting.

\_\_\_\_\_ **CLOTHING COMMITTEE** – Responsible for help sell league apparel at various events and development of new styles and items.

\_\_\_\_\_ **PARK IMPROVEMENT WORKER** – Help with labor on upcoming construction projects at the ball fields.
