# DGSA LEAGUE DIVISIONS

AGES 5 -15

**U6 LEAGUE:** (girls 5 & 6 years old) **Age 5 by January 1, 2010 and not over 6 on January 1, 2010.** This league will play Tuesday & Thursday nights normally 2 days per week at 5:15. Short practices followed by non-scored games. The goal of this league is to introduce the athletes to the concepts of softball. The season will last 4 weeks and begin June 8th and end in early July. Coach pitch only.

**U8 LEAGUE:** (Girls ages 7 & 8 years old) **Age 8 or under on January 1, 2010.** The girls will play on Tuesday & Thursday nights normally 2 days a week at 5:00 pm and 6:30 pm. Games will begin June 1st and end by mid July. The goal of this league is to introduce the concepts of softball to the athletes and to have the athletes compete in non-scored games. Coach pitch.

**U10 LEAGUE:** (Girls ages 9 & 10 years old) **Age 10 or under on January 1, 2010.** The girls will play on Monday and Wednesday nights normally 2 days per week at 5:00pm, 6:30pm, or 8:00pm. Games will begin June 7<sup>th</sup> and end around July 22nd. The goal of this league is to teach softball fundamentals, play in scored games and introduce basic softball strategy. Player pitch. Scored Games. A league playoff will take place July 19-22, 2010.

**U12 LEAGUE:** (Girls ages 11 & 12 years old) **Age 12 or under on January 1, 2010.** The girls will play on Tuesday & Thursday nights normally 2 days a week at 5:00 pm, 6:30 pm, or 8:00pm. Games will begin June 1st and end around July 22nd. The goal of this league is to re-enforce softball fundamentals and teach softball strategy following ASA age appropriate guidelines. Player pitch. Scored Games. A league playoff will take place July 19-22, 2010.

**SENIOR LEAGUE:** (Girls ages 13 through 15 years old) **Age 15 or under on January 1, 2010.** The girls will play on Monday and Wednesday at 4:30 pm, 6:30pm, or 8:00pm normally 2 days per week. Games will begin June 14 and end around July 28th. The goal of this league is to teach softball fundamentals and softball strategy following age appropriate ASA guidelines. Athletes who are entering this league for the first year will need to participate in a try-out session in March or April to help place girls on teams. A league playoff will take place July 26-28, 2010.

**DE PERE FIRE TOURNAMENT TEAMS:** (U10, U12 and U14 teams). These teams will play in various tournaments in the area on some of the weekends in June and July. All tournament team players must also play in one of the above leagues. (See separate tournament team guidelines for full details).

# DGSA Tournament Team Guidelines

## Purpose:

- A.) To provide DGSA girls in the U10, U12 and U14 age divisions an opportunity to play softball against teams outside of the normal DGSA league.
- B.) Sportsmanship, skill development and having fun will be the primary objectives, but winning and competition does have a higher priority on tournament teams than it does in normal league play.
- C.) To provide the De Pere and West De Pere school districts with fundamentally sound players ready for high school play.

## Guidelines:

- A.) Preseason tryouts will be required to insure that all girls have the skills needed to play safe tournament ball and to determine team placement. If skill development is not at a level for tournament team play the player will not be assigned a team. The goal however will be to allow all girls that are qualified the opportunity to play. Tryouts will take place in February and March. You must tryout to play.
- B.) Players are not guaranteed equal playing time, but some opportunity to play in each tournament in which they are active will be guaranteed even though it maybe limited. In order to achieve a number of players manageable for each tournament (approximately 12), some players may be deemed inactive by the coaching staff for a given tournament.
- C.) Each team will strive to play in four to six tournaments.
- D.) On the field player positions will be determined by the coach and may be limited to one or more positions.
- E.) A commitment to be at practices is a requirement of playing on a tournament team. Playing time can be affected by missing practices.
- F.) Players must play in their respected age division. No moving up to another age class will be allowed.

## Eligibility:

- A.) To be a Player on a DGSA Tournament Team you must be a current player on a DGSA league team.
- B.) The Player must attend a public or private school in the East or West De Pere School Districts or have principle residence in the East or West De Pere School District.

## Team Formation:

- A.) Team rosters will be formed based on the number of players and coaches in each age division. Priority of formation is as follows;
  - 1.) Players will be split into West and East De Pere teams. If numbers do not warrant a separate team for each school a combined team will be formed.
  - 2.) If player numbers warrant a second team for a particular school, the teams will be split up a.) by first year and second year eligibility; and then b.) by coach's discretion.
  - 3.) If a team is short players to make a roster or fill a particular position for a tournament, players may be shared between tournament teams. If a tournament player from another team is not available the coach will use best judgment in finding a substitute player to avoid having to forfeit a tournament or game. Players from outside the tournament program will only be used to avoid a forfeit.

## Registration:

Cost - \$125.00 due at registration. This does not include the cost of the player's uniform and any travel expense that may be involved.

## Tournament Team Uniformity Policy:

Each team will be supplied equipment and the uniforms that shall be used to keep a consistent DGSA appearance for all teams at the tournaments. Special allowances for fund raising and appearance will be allowed for teams traveling to a national tournament. These allowances must be approved by the DGSA league president.

## **VOLUNTEER POSITIONS: DGSA CONCESSION STAND COMMITTEE**

**CONCESSION STAND COORDINATOR:** Oversees and manages the operation of the Optimist Park concession stand with the assistance of members of the Concession Stand Committee and volunteers at large.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. Schedules and conducts Concession Stand Committee meetings as needed (approximately 1-2x/season) and communicates dates and times of such meetings to its members.
2. Attends DGSA Board meetings as required (approximately 1x/year to provide financial report) and serves as the liaison between the Concession Stand Committee and the DGSA Board.
3. Recruits members of the Concession Stand Committee to fill positions essential to successfully maintaining the concession stand (i.e. purchaser, schedulers, and opener/closers).
4. Works with Purchasing team to determine goods to be sold and appropriate prices for such goods.
5. Works with DGSA Treasurer to ensure accurate reporting of deposits and withdrawals to and from the concession stand.
6. Oversees overall management of the concession stand and its volunteers to ensure the stand is being adequately and properly operated. (May require serving as a back up Opener/Closer when necessary).

Volunteers Needed: 1-2 (if co-chair desired). Background check is required.

**SCHEDULER:** Schedule each softball team to appropriate time slot(s) for volunteering in concession stand and ensure that volunteers will be available to fill necessary slots.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. Meets 1 to 2 times with other schedulers in early spring to set up team volunteer schedule.
2. Drafts master volunteer schedule and distributes to DGSA President and Web Master.
3. Drafts separate volunteer team schedule and distributes to coach of each team.
4. Receives completed volunteer lists from coaches.
5. Follows up with individual volunteers via phone call or e-mail reminding them of the day and time they volunteered to serve at the stand.

Volunteers Needed: 2-4

**OPENER AND CLOSER:** Ensures that individual volunteers at large are equipped and prepared to serve customers at concession stand.

Opener's Responsibilities:

1. Present 30-45 minutes prior to opening of concession stand to conduct the following:
  - a. Start popcorn machine
  - b. Prepare food such as hot dogs or hamburgers
  - c. Start pretzel machine
  - d. Clean counters and any other areas needed
  - e. Set up condiments
  - f. Place money in drawers
2. Instructs and assists individual volunteers at large of their responsibilities in the concession stand.

Closer's Responsibilities:

1. Present 30 minutes prior to closing of concession stand to conduct the following:
  - a. Clean out popcorn machine
  - b. Wipe out pretzel machine
  - c. Place warm foods (hot dogs/hamburgers) in refrigerator/cooler
  - d. Restock cooler and candy
  - e. Clean counters and any other areas needed
  - f. Count money
2. Makes deposit at designated bank.
3. Gets designated amount of money to assigned Opener prior to next assigned date.
4. Notifies Purchaser of needed supplies or goods.
5. Notifies DGSA Treasurer of deposit.

Volunteers needed: 8 Commitment required: 1 night (Mon-Thurs.) per week (mid-May to late July).

**PURCHASER:** Assures that concession stand is properly equipped and stocked with necessary equipment and products to serve both the volunteer and customers' needs.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. Negotiates contracts and manages such contracts with appropriate vendors for needed products.
2. Works with Coordinator to decide products to be sold and appropriate prices for such products.
3. Communicates with Openers/ Closers regarding necessary products.
4. Directly purchases from stores and transports equipment and products to concession stand.
5. Sets up delivery time and meets with vendors at concession stand for delivery of products.

Volunteers needed: 1-2 Background check is required.
